AHMF REPORT: Presented by Albert Budworth

A newsletter was published.

At the teleconference on 19 June, the Council of Heritage Clubs NSW, advised it was pulling out of Australian Heritage Motoring Federation.

TMR REPORT: Presented by Albert Budworth

Advised the closing date for consultation replies for the *Qld Written-Off Vehicle Scheme* has been extended, probably to 30 September.

#### **GENERAL BUSINESS:**

When contacting QHMC please use your club's full name (not initials) to ensure we know which club.

All Correspondence distributed by delegates or visitors at QHMC meetings MUST be approved by the majority of the Management Committee.

If the Club has NOT received the Minutes or the Agenda by the 15th Day of the month, please contact the QHMC President.

At present, all vehicles in Qld up to 16 years old, if written off, have to be 'crushed', ie no recycling of any parts, The objective is to prevent criminals rebirthing vehicles and parts. This is the purpose the *Qld Written Off Vehicle Scheme*.

The proposal in the Consultation Paper (sent to QHMC), is to extend coverage to all vehicles, ie including historical vehicles of all types, coverage means there would be no recycling of any parts. Thus the Consultation Paper is inviting comments on this proposed change to legislation.

A delegate presented his opinion that the Paper contains a lot of errors.

Delegates raised a wide range of concerns (including the wide range of vehicles affected- tractors, trucks, buses, motor cycles and cars), the mental health of enthusiasts, and the economic value and contributions of the historical vehicle motoring community, also mentioned were: military vehicles which are supplied for the Anzac Day marches and historical vehicles are used to support charities and fund raising activities.

Many stakeholders are not aware of the impacts of this proposed legislation, eg crash repair shops, QHMC will contact the media and insurance companies. The community needs to be made aware of the Government's proposal.

QHMC is urging member clubs and individuals to respond with comments to this proposed legislation (which will have far reaching consequences for the historical vehicle motoring community). A sample guideline for member Clubs to use and respond to the Consultation Paper will be sent to member clubs by QHMS in due course.

A Delegate drew attention to the Impromptu Events scheme where the rules are interpreted differently, where QHMC considers ASRF is providing misleading information to members

Another Delegate mentioned the RACQ's *Motorfest* was a great success.

A Delegate drew attention to the escalating cost of renting Council parks to hold a Club event
