**AHMF REPORT**. Presented by Albert Budworth

A Zoom Meeting was held and the main issue was Heavy Vehicle load Ratings.

The proposal to extend the "*QLD Vehicle Written Off Scheme*" to include SIVs was presented

**TMR REPORT** Presented by Albert Budworth

Reaction by Member Clubs of QHMC to the "*QLD Written Off Vehicle Scheme*" extension proposal has been substantial, noting the website posting has been taken down by TMR.

The 2 keys issues of this proposal are "cut off" age of Vehicles and WHO decides if a Vehicle is a write off.

A Delegate raised the issue of Life Members and the date to be on their membership cards.

The status of using SIVs for school formals was discussed, these can be properly made into a club event as a car show, and in remote areas, school formals generally become a community event.

In relation to being booked by a policeman, a Delegate mentioned there are different interpretations such as having the engine running or not or being on private property.

It was mentioned shopping centres and similar facilities are regarded as public places.

A delegate mentioned you cant sit in the drivers seat and use a mobile phone.

A Delegate raised the subject of Impromptu Events and how some clubs are misinterpreting the guidelines, issues such as not publishing the full information required to be compliant, also the driver of a SIV needs to prove they're on a club sanctioned run.

Some clubs organise numerous Impromptu Event runs, others organise few runs.

- only immediate family, and not extended (aunts and uncles for example). Immediate family includes parents, sons and daughters, grandparents and grandchildren*
- carriage is free, there is no fee or donation involved*
