QHMC EVENTS REPORT:

A reminder of the Swap Meet to be held on 18 October was presented. This will be held at the VCCA(Q) Club rooms at Carindale. This will be for English and European vehicle and motor cycle parts only.

All Correspondence distributed by delegates or visitors at QHMC meetings MUST be approved by the majority of the Management Committee.

A Vehicle Classification system from New Zealand with classifications based on intervals of dates was discussed (after it was emailed to all member clubs). It was mentioned that AHMC had adopted an alternative system in 2000, and HMCCQ have a classification system too. The purpose here is to advise all clubs that alternative classification systems exist.

Revision of the Constitution is required every five years; this has been done by the Management Committee and will be forwarded with the Annual Return. These changes are minor and are in the nature of tidying up.

It was mentioned in NSW, the Motor Registry is refusing to Register Westfield and similar kit cars unless they have an engineering certificate, this is not required in Queensland.

Vice President mentioned that DTMR has a newly introduced a form, *Statement of Acquisition*, it was mentioned in discussion that that this would apply to vehicles, trailers and caravans and might be designed to protect DTMR from rebirthing and consequences of the Vehicle Written Off Scheme. Also, if a person wanting to Register a vehicle has no receipt of proof of purchase, they will be required to sign this form

BVVC mentioned that Safety (Road Worthy) Certificates for vehicles built before 2002, are becoming harder to obtain because of the time and cost of doing the work,

Car yards in Qld can issue new number plates for newly Registered vehicles they sell

Assistant Secretary mentioned some driving instructors are teaching students to use both feet on an automatic vehicle
